

Crowe repeats as area's top bowler

For the second consecutive week, Tom Crowe rolled the high game and series to earn the weekly high honors. Crowe opened Rolling Thunder League action with a great 269 individual game to help his cause. He followed with games of 189 and 212 to finish with a 670 total.

Mike Unger posted the second high series with a 257 high game contributing toward a 659 set.

Other good individual games were Steve Zeplin (257), Rob Lyman (247) and Mark Svatek (247).

Olivia Jackson posted the women's high series with a 203 high game helping toward a 578 total in Rolling Thunder play.

Terri Mason (214-558) and Valerie Hudgens both rolled individual games of 214.

Sharon Guinn is another local bowler who scored well during the recent Texas Women's State Tournament. Bowling with a team from Austin, Sharon placed third in Div 1 doubles with Amy Gutierrez with a score of 1,464, 25th in Div 1 all events with 2,086 and 10th in team with NDO Prime Time.

The team roster consisted of Norma Mann, Joi Bell, Amy Gutierrez and Guinn. Guinn also won fifth-place money in the 500/600 175 and above average senior division.

The 41st Annual Victoria Latin Bowlers Tournament was held last weekend at Century Lanes with great scores being posted, unfortunately no local teams were able to crack the team prize list this year.

In the women's division, Kiss This, from San Antonio, was the runaway winner with a score of 6,485. Individuals on the team were Jenn Martinez, Whitney Harris, Jessica Hirschmann, Latoya Williams and Denise Barrett. The second-place team was RIBF's (6,402), from Corpus Christi, and placing third was Black Ice (6,380), from Houston. Also placing in the money were NDO (6,322), from Houston, in fourth place and We've Got More (6,295), from Austin, in fifth.

Ashley Blakely, of Houston, bowled a 300 game during Sunday's competition.

Blakely also won the individual event with a six-game score of 1,486. Second-place money was won by Jovan Albalarosa (1,392) from San Antonio. Heather Greer (1,390) from Corpus Christi placed third.

The men's division also saw perfection with Demitri Cruz, of Denton, bowling a 300 game Sunday.

Istrike Sports Prime Time from San Antonio won the men's team event with a score of 6,626. Team members were Matt Gosser, Justin Jewel, Michael Keith, Luis Deleon and Larry McCauley. Team Cabanski (6,602) won second-place money and Draft Beer Weekend ((6,602) placed third.

In the individual event, four Victoria bowlers placed in the money. Jordan Hornes (1,476), who hails from Detroit, won first-place money. Local bowler Mark Svatek (1,447) placed second and Justin Jewel (1,409), from Helotes, placed third. Local bowlers also cashing in the individual event were Michael Conchola (1,379), who placed eighth, and Steve Zeplin and Joe Blount, who tied for ninth with a score of (1,378). Svatek posted the high scratch of the tournament with a 773.

As usual, tournament manager Lee Caballero and the rest of the Victoria Latin Bowlers Club members worked very hard to make this a successful

tournament. Thanks to Century Lanes for hosting the tournament with over 450 bowlers participating.
