

Zeplin leads 700 trio (11.9.2023)

Left-hander Steve Zeplin posted the high series in Thursday Sundowners action which produced three 700 plus bowlers.

Zeplin was on target all night with games of 257, 268, and 213 for a 738 total. After starting the first game with six consecutive strikes, he left and spared the 7-pin and the 8-pin in consecutive frames, which stopped his string of strikes and prevented a higher game. In the second game he struck the front five before a 6-pin stopped his string. Steve suffered only one open frame for the night in the third game when he missed the 7-pin. Overall he said that he had a pretty good shot with some hold area to roll 22 strikes in the series.

Eric Yeager was a little more consistent to post the second high with individual games of 244, 235, and 236 for a 715. He rolled 24 strikes in his set with one open split frame in the first game. The third person to break 700 was Matthew Flores who had a bad start with a 180 first game with one open split and unable to roll a double. He found his strike line the second game to roll a 243 and then started the third game with 10 strikes before leaving the 3-9 pins on the 11th ball to finish with a 287 and a 710 total. T.J. Mooney led the Monday Mixed league with individuals of 179, 279, and 233 for a 691. He also rolled a 258-669 on Thursday night.
